University of Dubai wins 2011 Global Business Education Award

EUROPEAN CEO Global Business Education Award

European CEO Magazine announced this week that it has named the University of Dubai (UD) the Most Innovative Business School in the Middle East in its 2011 Global Business Education Awards.

The award was based on such factors as accreditation, accessibility, value for money, diversity of curriculum and methodology, size (student to teacher ratios), graduation rate, admissions procedures, placement potential, training in technology, holistic approach and sustainability.

Anthony Michael, European CEO Magazine Awards Administrator said the award selection panel used a wide range of criteria to inform its decision, lending the critical eye of a collective 175 years of business journalism to the exhaustive information gathered by the award body's research team.

UD President Dr. Omar Hefni said, "This is a great honor. This award reaffirms our idea that high-quality business education must remain our top priority. Our exceptional faculty and staff work hard to give our students the very best business education and we take great pride in being recognized by such a well-informed publication as European CEO Magazine."

The winners of the Global Business Awards, which also includes categories such as 'CEO of the Year' and 'Best Private Banking,' were announced on the European CEO Magazine website and the list will be published in its entirety in the magazine's December/January issue.

"Educational development continues to be highlighted by our readers as a topic of great concern," Michael said, "They appreciate that to develop a modern business, staff must be trained to the very highest possible standards."

UD RECEIVES \$500,000 GRANT TO HELP IMPROVE TWO IRAQI UNIVERSITIES

The University of Dubai (UD) recently won a grant of \$500,000 (Dh 1,836,500) for its proposal to help two Iraqi universities improve the quality of their business education. The grant, awarded to UD last week by the United States Agency for International Development (USAID), was created to improve the educational system in Iraq, with an emphasis on finance and banking.

University of Dubai President, Dr. Omar Hefni, said it is part of the school's social responsibility to support the rebuilding of Iraq. Faculty at UD saw the grant as an opportunity to use their experience and expertise to do something helpful, he said, and they took it.

The University of Dubai will assist Al Monsour University College (AMUC), located in Baghdad, in assessing its potential for obtaining an accreditation from the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB) – an accreditation UD holds, along with other notable schools, such as Harvard Business School and Stanford University.

"We know this is a very big challenge," UD Chief Academic Officer, Dr. Ananth Rao, said. "But it is one of our responsibilities as an accredited university. If we are asked, 'What did you do as an accredited university,' we would like to say, 'we helped two business schools raise their standards.' And those two business schools will then have the ability to raise the standards of two more business schools in the region."

We are proud to say that our Alumni Student Mentoring Program grew by almost 30 percent this year to 27 pairs.

This year's ASMP Orientation Day was held on Oct. 13 in the Dubai Chamber. The orientation was held in two different sessions to accommodate the number of participants, and ensure they understood the objectives, benefits, and guidelines of the program.

We would like to invite professional mentors and coaches in the industry to guide alumni mentors on proper mentoring techniques in an effort to solidify the

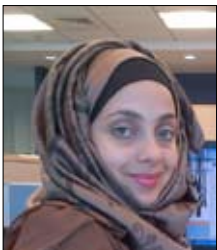
Ziad Ratib Abo Owun ('05 CIS)
